Charge:

In consultation with the Coordinators Planning Group, the New IT Interest Group will facilitate discussions of new instructional technologies, such as podcasting, simulations, games and social networking, that might have potential for LILI instruction. The group will share information about new instructional technologies and their possible application for LILI instruction. This is not an implementation group. Should the group want to recommend a campus LILI initiative involving new IT, it would make a recommendation to the Coordinators Planning Group that in turn would make a decision about the initiative and, if a decision is made to proceed, would develop an implementation plan.

Makeup of Group: An Instruction Coordinator; a Facilitator; and interested library staff who ask to be on the group email list.

Reporting on Group Activities and Sharing Resources:

- At the end of the fall and spring semesters, the group will send the Instruction Coordinators Planning Group a brief summary highlighting its activities for the previous semester and listing any new plans it's considering for the upcoming one.
- Any information about new IT that the group discovers or develops that it thinks will be of use to campus instruction librarians should be shared (in a timely fashion!) with our community through InfoLit and/or through the LILI Clearinghouse.
